Impact Level: High - Core Functionality Changes

Overview

SELMA is implementing significant changes to how Work-based Training (WBT) data is sent to and received from the Tertiary Education Commission (TEC) through the new DXP integration. This update modernises our data exchange processes while introducing new data fields and improved user interfaces.

What's Changing

Core System Changes

The primary change involves the technical infrastructure for sending and receiving WBT data to/from TEC. While the general premise of WBT reporting remains similar, there are important changes to:

- New fields Additional TEC requirements
- Data validation Improved real-time feedback
- User interface Modernised transaction monitoring
- Off-job Delivery reporting New process
- Backfill of Off-job Delivery data and reporting New upload feature

Affected Funding Types:

- Non-degree Delivery at Levels 3-7 on the NZQCF (DQ3-7)
- Trades Academies

New Data Fields & Requirements

Learner (Student) Records

The learner record is now its own separate transaction with expanded data collection:

New fields expected by TEC:

- IRD Number Enables Fees Free entitlement matching
- **Gender** Demographic data collection
- Name ID Code Identity validation (first 4 characters of surname + first name initial)
- First Year of Tertiary Education Educational history tracking
- Overseas Country Code International student eligibility validation
- Country of Citizenship Funding eligibility determination
- **Disability Status** Alignment with enrollment forms
- Disability Support Needs Accommodation tracking
- Disability Services Accessed Indicator Service monitoring
- Occupation Code Better training-to-occupation understanding (applies to the Training Agreement)
- **Employee Territorial Authority** Learning location specification (applies to the Training Agreement)
- **Employee Region Code** Geographic detail for learning location (applies to the Training Agreement)

Note: The "School Student Belongs To" field needs to be set to the identifying EDUMIS before it can be reported to the DXP.



Programme Information

New Fields:

- NZSCED Field of Study Programme classification for DQ3-7 funding
- Study Type Code Replaces 'Funding Source Code' for WBT
- Occupation Code Links programmes to specific occupations and serves as default if not set on the Learner (Student)
- Mode of Delivery Code A funding determination requirement



• Maximum Programme Fee - Fee transparency across vocational education

WBT Training Agreement

The following new required fields are sourced from other entities in SELMA:

- Employer NZBN New Zealand Business Number for accurate employer identification (SELMA Organisation label updated from Registration Number to NZ Business Number)
- Employment Regional Code Geographic employment detail
- Employment Territorial Authority Code Geographic employment detail
- Occupation Code Better training-to-occupation understanding


- Parent Enrolment Local ID Complex programme tracking
- Residential Status NZ resident status for funding eligibility
- Australian Residential Status Australian permanent resident status
- Funding Source Type Code Replaces previous funding source methodology
- Mode of Delivery Code Work-based learning delivery method
- Study Type Code Replaces 'Funding Source Code' field
- **Deletion Date** Audit trail enhancement

User Interface Improvements

Visual Indicators

- New WBT validation icons for required fields
- Clear field validation with immediate feedback
- New programme creation workflow
- New learner creation workflow
- Updated enrolment workflow




Employment Regional Code field filters the Employment Territorial Authority list of values.

Note: The same behaviour and notification occur when creating a new Programme in SELMA and submitted it to the DXP.






Study Type Code and Funding Source now on the Enrol Student selection screen


Enhanced Transaction Monitoring

- Sliding window interface for viewing DXP API transaction history
- Real-time status updates instead of log screen reviews
- Improved error messaging with actionable feedback




Sliding window interface for viewing SELMA to DXP transaction history






WBT Log tab displays data direct from DXP and shows past transaction history








Enrolment Actions "WBT Fetch Enrolment" displays data directly from the DXP

Off-job Delivery Management

Previously reporting as Funding Source 11 via SDR – now reported directly to DXP from the SLEMA Enrolment Component.


- Toggle switch for Off-job Delivery components
- Provider selection dropdown with integrated reporting
- Dedicated messaging section for DXP communications







Training Plan Visits – previously known as MAC Visits

For NZA enrolments, the label in the Event type dropdown list has been changed from MAC Visit to **TP Visit**, meaning a Train Plan site visit. This is to better align with TEC terminology given they are no longer associated with Managed Apprenticeships.








Successful submission of a TP Visit results in a positive message being displayed.

Simply update the TP Visit Event and resubmit again.




Enrolment Event Log now displays the TP Visit has been notified to the DXP

• Title of the Grid Report changed to TP VISITS - use to assist with reconciliation in knowing what has and has not been reported to the DXP.



Feature Availability

The follow features are available in SELMA for WBT:

- Register new programmes (simple and complex)
- Create/update learners
- Enrol student
- Training agreements (automatically created upon enrolling a student)
- WBT enrolment (automatically created upon enrolling a student)
- Training plans (automatically created upon enrolling a student)
- Off-job training delivery reporting
- Withdrawal processes (both automated & manual)
- Hold/restart functionality (status update)
- Grace period management (status update and automated expiry)
- Programme expiry and maximum fee updates
- Training plan visits
- DXP WBT record viewing (fetch)
- Bulk off-job training delivery creation or update (enrolment component upload facility) for backfilling purposes
- Programme enrolment deletion
- Programme versioning



• Learner transfers from one programme another, and from one version to another (simple and complex programmes)

The following feature is not currently supported in SELMA:

Learner fees reporting

Important Notes

System Behavior Changes

- **No more log screen reviews** New intuitive messaging system (old log screen retained for historical purposes)
- Immediate responses Real-time success/failure feedback
- Enhanced error handling Actionable error messages with validation details
- **Two-step off-job process** Currently requires component update, then reporting (under review)
- Bulk upload of Off-job training delivery components Get in touch for more info
